

# Broken Arrow Round-Up Club

## Playday Rules

1. You must be a member of the BARUC to qualify for year-end awards. Your age on January 1 will determine the category in which you compete throughout the playday season. You must have a paid membership, or application pending, in order for your playday points to count
2. In order to qualify for year-end awards, work requirement of 15 hours per membership must be met. A sign-up sheet will be available at playday sign in. Work hours may be met at work days, rodeo, playdays, and arena rental events, or by assisting with various clerical or advertising tasks.
3. Participants under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian present during the entire playday. All participants are required to have a signed Club Waiver on file. No stallions allowed at playdays.
4. Participants in the lower age groups (Lead Line, 7 & Under, etc.) will not qualify for the All-Around Hi-Point Award unless the pattern they run is the same as that run by the older age groups.
5. Once your age group has begun, there will be no more entries allowed for that event or any other event in your age group.
6. Your name will be called three times for your playday event and then you will forfeit your run on that event with no refund of entry fee.
7. You must ride in 12 playday events to qualify for a year-end award. A Hi-Point Award is given in each age group provided there have been two or more qualified competitors in that group. An award will also be given at year-end to all qualifying participants in the 18 & under age categories. Points will be accumulated for members only.
8. The All-Around award is given to the person who has run the best times at the playdays. It does not necessarily go to the person with the highest cumulative point score among the various age groups. This may necessitate keeping two sets of books- one by age group and another that includes all participants, subject to rule #4.
9. If the All-Around is also Hi-Point for his/her age group, the Hi-Point award for the age group will go to the second Hi-Point person in that age group who has ridden in 12 playday events.
10. There shall be no drug use on BARUC premises at any time. There shall be no one attending intoxicated and no drinking of alcoholic beverages at BARUC playdays.
11. Proof of a negative Coggins is required at all events. Bring your papers if not already recorded.
12. You do not have to ride the same horse in each event to qualify for an award. You may ride a different horse in each event if you so wish and you will qualify for all the points in each of these events. If, however, you ride two horses in the same event, you must designate which run counts for the points before you make the run
13. Jeans/riding pants and riding shoes required to be worn by all playday participants. No tennis shoes or shorts allowed on horseback. No spaghetti-strap tops.
14. Before points are figured, all non-member placings will be removed and member placings moved up
